Sweet Road depicts life in the outback for several individuals. Every character has a reason for being there and their circumstances lead them to a new destiny. Debra Oswald's writing takes us into the lives of very real people who find themselves searching for everything we all seek - happiness. It's not an easy ride but it will draw you into the emotional path of each character. There are many twists and turns in their travels. We have no doubt that you will find yourself engrossed in their journey.

Rehearsal Information.

Venue: Rehearsals will be held at the Pymble Players Inc Theatre, 55A Mona Vale Road Pymble (Cnr Bromley Avenue – entrance via Bromley Avenue)

Rehearsals will be two evenings a week, generally on Monday and Wednesday evenings from 6.30pm – 9.30pm. There may be some weekend rehearsals as we approach performance dates. So please ensure you are available. These evenings are merely a proposal and we will amend as required.
